



Indian Equitable Learning Ecosystem Fellowship 2023-24: Concept Note

Introduction

Quest Alliance envisions a world where young people thrive as self-learners. Technology in education serves as a self-learning tool that empowers students to learn at their own pace. However, it is evident that not everyone has equitable access to technology.

In collaboration with the Scratch Education Collaborative (SEC), Quest Alliance aims to address this gap by fostering a community of collaborative creators who can provide tech-enabled creative learning experiences for children. The Scratch Foundation shares our commitment to delivering children worldwide with free access to technology, specifically the coding tool <u>Scratch</u>. Together, we envision a community where creativity is expressed through stories, innovation, and collaboration.

Background

In India, the digital divide and poor digital infrastructure pose significant challenges, preventing learners from underserved communities from utilizing technology for creative learning. To make creative experiences more equitable and accessible, we propose the Indian Equitable Learning Fellowship. This fellowship will involve 20 individuals from 10 grassroots organisations across different regions of the country, with Quest Alliance serving as the anchor organisation.





Objective

The overall objective of the Indian Equitable Ecosystem program is to create a movement around gender and equity using computational thinking/coding as a tool. The program is expected to enhance the self-efficacy of learners by building solutions and relating to the identity of a problem-solver.

Specific objectives of the program would include:

- To ensure accessibility of creative platforms to the students of underserved communities through fellowships.
- To capacitate Fellows to facilitate computational thinking and gender with learners and educators.
- To create a pool of resources and build scholarships for computational thinking.

- Facilitate sessions on computational thinking and gender with learners and educators.
- Work to create tech-enabled creative learning environments in schools or within their program ecosystems.
- Actively participate in the fellowship process, which includes training sessions, catch-up calls, reviews, documentation, and program-related events.

Fellows Persona

- Willingness to learn creative methods of engagement with students.
- Experience of working with students in the school/community ecosystem.
- Expertise in designing learning experiences and facilitation sessions.
- Have deep concerns for equity and inclusion, and be gender sensitive.
